Upon the order of Special Referee Elizabeth Shamahs, issued the 6th day of March, 2024 granting to the plaintiff certified class, defined in the December 17, 2019 Order of Honorable Andrew Borrok, J.S.C. as:

All persons employed by Defendant or subcontracted by Defendant through Network of Patrols, Inc. at any time from April 26, 2011 through December 17, 2019 who worked as non-union flaggers on public works projects in the State of New York

(NYSCEF Doc. No. 84), an order for judgment upon a referral to hear and determine damages owed on a grant of summary judgment as to liability by Honorable Andrew Borrok, J.S.C., dated May 11, 2021 (NYSCEF Doc. No. 192), and a hearing as to damages held on January 4 and 5, 2023, against the defendant Judlau Contracting, Inc., located at 26-15 Ulmer Street, College Point, NY 11354, in the amount of \$26,984,101.16 plus prejudgment interest thereon, at the rate of 9%, from April 26, 2017 through the date of the judgment;

ADJUDGED, that the plaintiffs, a certified class defined as:

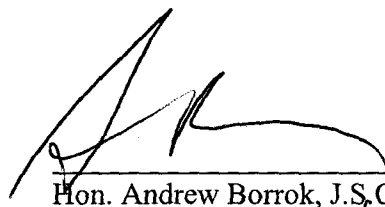

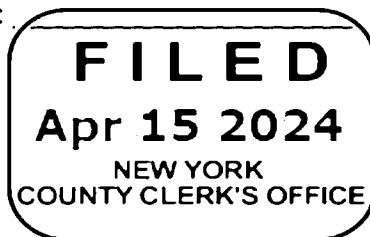

Taylor B. Graham, Esq., affirms under penalty of perjury as follows:

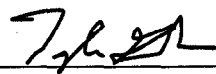
1. I am a member of the bar of the State of New York.
